Emergency Ordinance #EO2020-01 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE RELATING TO A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY INVOLVING THE COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS AND AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY ORDER EO-01 SHELTER IN PLACE AND HARBOR QUARANTINE POLICY, Patricia Cottle/Kimberly Nelson move to approve Emergency Ordinance #EO2020-01 an emergency ordinance relating to a public health emergency involving the COVID-19 coronavirus and authorizing emergency order EO-01 shelter in place and harbor quarantine policy, (which shall remain in effect until 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, April 21, 2020, and shall supersede all conflicting laws during the existence of this emergency, and further authorizes the Mayor to extend the below emergency regulations to remain in effect up to and until 11:59 p.m. on May 30, 2020, or to rescind such emergency regulations if the COVID-19 public health emergency abates.) **Motion carried unanimously**

Emergency Ordinance # EO2020-02 AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY PERMITTING THE TELEPHONIC PARTICIPATION IN CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS BY THE MAYOR, THE CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS, AND THE PUBLIC, DUE TO HEALTH CONCERNS RELATED TO THE COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS,


